



USF's NEW Program in National and Competitive Intelligence

USF recently received a grant to help develop the “next generation of intelligence analysts.” High school students can be a part of this college-level program, which is funded by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence.

Developing the same skills needed in any profession, good analytical abilities and sound judgment that shapes decision-making, this program will also bolster students' presentation skills and strengthen their ability to gather data for analysis.

USF will offer workshops exclusively for IB high school students throughout the school year and host a four-day seminar over the summer.

The workshops (slated for non-school days for public schools) will give students a chance to:

- o Learn from speakers in the intelligence industry, discussing topics ranging from satellite imagery to cyber-security to public health,
- o Spend a day on the USF campus and interact with college students and university professors,
- o Research a topic and present conclusions, and
- o Participate in writing sessions.
